### *Jesus, Son of Joseph*

#### **As We Gather**

In Jesus' genealogy, we recognize Joseph, the head of Jesus' earthly family. At the time of Jesus' birth, Joseph was caring, not wanting to shame his fiancée Mary, and he was obedient, naming her son Jesus. Yet Joseph is not mentioned in the Bible after the account of Jesus' getting "lost" in the temple when He was twelve years old. But God did not forget Joseph! "Jesus" means "Savior," and He is Joseph's Savior, the Savior of all the unknown people in and out of His family tree, and our Savior. God remembers all people, well-known or not, and He has forgiven and forgotten all our sins, their penalty paid by Joseph's "adopted" Son. Come quickly, Son of Joseph.

And I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. <sup>10</sup>And I will appoint a place for my people Israel and will plant them, so that they may dwell in their own place and be disturbed no more. And violent men shall afflict them no more, as formerly, <sup>11</sup>from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel. And I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover, the LORD declares to you that the LORD will make you a house. . . .

<sup>16</sup>And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.”
