## NEW YEAR'S DAY & CIRCUMCISION AND NAMING OF JESUS

*And at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. (Luke 2:21)*

While the culture marks the beginning of a new year on January 1<sup>st</sup> each year, the church marches to the beat of a different drummer and begins a new year on the First Sunday of Advent. The significance of January 1<sup>st</sup> to us as Christians is that it is the eighth day after our celebration of Christ's birth at Christmas, the day we commemorate the circumcision and naming of Jesus. This was done for our Lord according to the Law of God in Leviticus 12:3, "*And on the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.*"

There is much that can be said that our Lord was circumcised, but perhaps most comforting to us is how from the very first days of His life He is already fulfilling the Law of God for us, in our place. Galatians 4:4-5 says, "*God sent His Son, born of a woman, **born under the law**, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive our adoption as son.*" Born under the Law! Jesus is our Savior, not just because He died for us, but because He lived for us the life of obedience that we could not. And already on the eighth day we see His life of perfect obedience being lived for us, that we might become the children of God through Him. Thanks be to God for our perfect Savior!
