WELCOME, VICAR JON AND FAMILY! – Last Sunday, we formally welcomed *Vicar Jon Pietrowski* to his role at St. John. Going forward, he will have open office hours at St. John each week on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m. As a Convertible Vicar, he will serve our congregation under the supervision of *Rev. Aaron Bueltmann* of St. John Stryker. Vicar Jon may be contacted for prayer requests, counsel, or other matters you would typically bring to your pastor.

Note: As we transition from weekly guest pastors to the consistent leadership of Vicar Jon, we ask for your patience and prayers during this adjustment period. Over the coming weeks, you may notice a few changes to our services, bulletin formats, and other routines as we learn to work together and settle into new patterns of ministry. Thank you for your grace, patience, and support during this exciting new chapter in the life of our congregation.

THURSDAY EVENING SERVICES – We are happy to announce that Thursday Evening Worship services have resumed for the summer each Thursday at 7 p.m. Services will be held in the sanctuary. Each Thursday evening service will be the same as the coming Sunday's morning service with one exception: on communion weeks, we will have a guest Pastor to ensure that communion can be served on the Thursdays prior to communion Sundays.

This coming Thursday, June 18th, **Pastor Kern** will be leading the Thursday Service at St. John Freedom, while Vicar Pietrowski travels to lead the service at St. John Stryker (*St. John Stryker is on a 2nd and 4th Sunday Communion schedule, opposite of St. John Freedom*).

NEW MEMBER CLASSES – Vicar Jon will be leading New Member Classes beginning on **Sunday, June 28th**, during the Adult Bible Study hour following the service (around 10:15 a.m.). The classes will run for **ten weeks** and are open to everyone in the congregation—both those exploring new membership and also current members who would enjoy a refresher. If you are interested in the class but unable to attend on a Sunday morning, please contact Vicar Jon; he is happy to arrange a mid-week catch-up session.

To help families participate, **we hope to offer nursery care during the class**. If you would be willing to volunteer to watch the participants' children, there is a sign-up sheet on the Narthex table.
